**16 December: Stop Press: Closing date for submissions to the review of South Australia's planning system.** SECRA will be making a submission and if you would like to contribute to this process email [secra.sa@gmail.com](mailto:secra.sa@gmail.com) or wait until further details are released by the Expert Panel. The Planning Minister Nick Champion said the review's scope would cover:

- The Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016.
- The Planning and Design Code (and related instruments) "as it relates to infill policy, trees, character, heritage and car parking".
- The e-planning system "with a view to ensuring that it is delivering an efficient and user-friendly process and platform".
- The PlanSA Website "with a view to ensuring its usability and access to information by the community"
