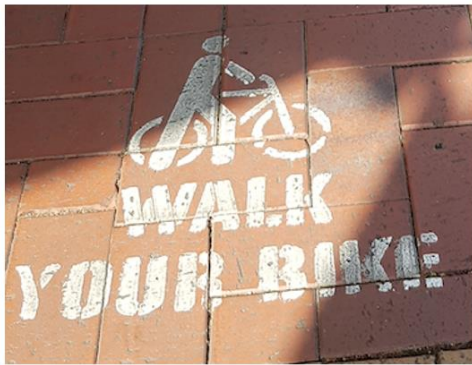
What needs to be done to achieve this objective?

HUTT STREET SHOULD BE SEEN AS A DESTINATION STREET NOT AN ARTERIAL ROAD INTO THE CITY



- **Traffic calming initiatives introduced by redesigning streetscape and providing separated road bike lanes.**
- **Commuters will then be encouraged to use the ring road with Pulteney or King William Streets to access the city.**

HUTT STREET SHOULD BE SEEN AS A SAFE STREET



- All pedestrian crossings to activate automatically (as per the lock down).
- New crossing at Carrington Street.
- No U turns between Halifax and Angas Streets.
- A 40 kph speed limit between South Terrace and Bartels Road.
- Footpath lighting improved.
- “Walk Your Bike” signage prior to alfresco footpath dining areas.

HUTT STREET SHOULD BE SEEN AS WELCOMING



- **Welcoming signage on Hutt Street at South Terrace and Bartels Road.**
- **A street that tells of its heritage by signage, lighting and buildings.**
- **Unseemly Davaar House site, the southern entrance to Hutt Street, to be addressed.**

HUTT STREET TRADERS RESILIENCE SHOULD BE RECOGNISED



- Council rates relief during the first six months of a new tenancy.
- A “Hutt Street App” that identifies and promotes Hutt Street businesses and provides discounts.
- Identify residents’ desirable businesses and services gaps on Hutt Street.

HUTT STREET SHOULD BE SEEN AS A GATEWAY TO ADELAIDES UNIQUE SOUTH EAST PARK LANDS



- **Signage be provided along Hutt Street to Park Lands such as Victoria Park, Park Lands Trail, Elm Carriage Way, Himeji Garden and Glover Playground.**
- **Council to publicise APPA's Park Lands guided walks in the vicinity of Hutt Street .**

HUTT STREET SHOULD BE SEEN AS A VIBRANT CULTURAL STREET



- **Signage to facilities such as the Bakehouse theatre, Halifax Cafe, WEA, Children's centre, St Johns Church, Oxfam.**
- **Council to support and promote cultural activities and local community markets in Hutt Street.**
