Dear Ms Redmond

The South East City Residents Association (SECRA) is an organisation committed to representing the residents of the south east precinct of the City of Adelaide and providing them with a voice to promote their interests and to preserve and enhance the inherent character and heritage of the neighbourhood including the adjacent area of the Park Lands, and in particular, Victoria Park.

In order to assist South East City Residents in deciding on which candidate to vote for in the coming State Election we seek your responses to the following questions by close of business on 15 March 2010. This will enable us to provide residents with a copy of your response so that they are aware of your party's policies in these areas of interest to them prior to the 20 March 2010 polling day.

If your party is successful in gaining the Government of South Australia in the coming election what will be your Government's policy in regard to:

1. The preservation of heritage buildings and streetscapes in the south east precinct of the city, in particular along East and South Terraces where unlisted heritage buildings are being demolished in favour of multi story, high density residential and commercial buildings?
2. The restoration of full planning powers to the Adelaide City Council's DAP which is the democratic right of the citizens of the City together with the restoration of Third Party appeal rights for Category 2 Development Applications?
3. The construction of permanent buildings on the Adelaide City Park Lands?
4. The City of Adelaide Council's Masterplan for Victoria Park?

5. The use of the Park Lands for car parking?
6. Improving the coordination and use of public transport and reducing the numbers of private vehicles being driven into the City of Adelaide?
7. The provision of safe lanes and tracks for cyclists and in particular a safe cyclist route for South East City residents to access the River Torrens Linear Park?

While some of the above questions may refer to issues where the Adelaide City Council has responsibility SECRA is interested in your response as experience in the past has shown that Governments have on occasions used legislation to override the Council on issues.

I am sure that you will recognise the value of having a fully informed electorate in the above matters.

Your response to the above seven questions by the close of business on 15 March 2010 is therefore requested to enable SECRA to provide residents with details of your response prior to the 20 March 2010 polling day.
